

Our Curriculum

WCA believes in a rigorous curriculum, enriched with Biblical Truth and the Core Knowledge Sequence, to challenge students to reach their full academic potential.

Accreditation

WCA is transitioning from the Kansas State Department of Education to accreditation from the Association of Christian School International (ACSI).

Teacher Certification

Our teachers are required to have a teaching license from the Kansas State Department of Education or ACSI.

Uniforms

We desire to have a school where learning is the focus and not what the students are wearing. Therefore, students attending WCA will be required to wear a uniform.

Tuition

Our yearly tuition is \$3,500 (or 10 monthly payments of \$350) plus additional fees to cover the cost of books, field trips, yearbooks and technology.

We offer a sibling discount for families with more than one child attending K - 8th grades. Example for a family with five students: child one: \$3,500, child two: \$2,700, child three: \$2,600, child four: \$2,500, child five: \$2,500.)

Admission Policy

The Wellington Christian Academy admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to the students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs, and athletic and other school-administered programs. 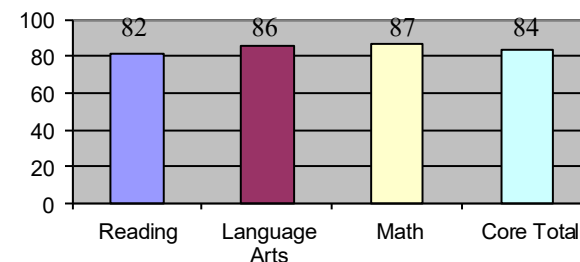
- **Math: 56% of WCA students scored in top two levels vs. 35% of all KS students.**
